SPARKing translation of academic research discoveries to clinical impact; lessons from success and failures

Professor Daria Mochly-Rosen

Dr. Daria Mochly-Rosen is a Professor of Chemical and Systems Biology at Stanford University where she leads multi-disciplinary research on the molecular mechanisms of diseases. She has published more than 290 papers and holds over 50 patents. She has founded three biotech companies, including KAI Pharmaceuticals (acquired by Amgen) and her research lead to several clinical trials.



Her experience in translating basic research to drug development led her to SPARK, Stanford's translational research program, in 2006. The SPARK model has now been adopted in more than 70 institutes on all continents and she serves as President and Founder of the SPARK GLOBAL organization.

In this webinar she will share with us her story on translating her research discoveries into therapeutics. She will share with us the countless lessons she has learned. She will tell us how her experience led to establishment of SPARK program and how SPARK has helped other projects to advance research discoveries from bench to bedside.
